### INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF ABSTRACTS

All Abstracts must be prepared in **standard grammatical English** and should be typed in single-line spacing throughout, using standard-sized (A4) paper. Arial 11 font size.

Authors will be held responsible for the abstract content and for compliance with these Instructions.

Please arrange the abstract as follows:

- Title of the abstract in low case and boldface type.

Ex: **236 children with developmental hydrocephalus: causes and clinical consequences**

- After a line of space, names of the authors (first names before surnames, no academic titles).

Ex: Hannah M Tully, Gisele Ishak, Tessa C Rue.

- Starting on the next line and after a line of space the authors' affiliations (**as brief as possible**): Department, Clinic or Institute (City, Country).

Ex; Division of Pediatric Neurosurgery, Saint Louis University of Medicine, Saint Louis, United States

After a line of space, the text of the abstract without indentation. **MAXIMUM ABSTRACT LENGTH: 2500 characters.**

Inclusion of Tables or Figures is not allowed.

· If needed please organize the abstract according to the following sections:

1. OBJECTIVES
2. MATERIAL AND METHODS
3. RESULTS
4. DISCUSSION
5. CONCLUSIONS.

Each section should start on a new line and section headings should appear in upper case and plain type.

Ex.

**OBJECTIVES:** Few systematic assessments of developmental forms of hydrocephalus exist.

**MATERIAL AND METHODS:** We reviewed MRIs and clinical records of patients with infancy-onset hydrocephalus.

**RESULTS:** Among 411 infants, 236 had hydrocephalus with no recognizable extrinsic cause. These children were assigned to one of five subtypes and compared on the basis of clinical characteristics, developmental and surgical outcomes. At an average age of 5.3 years, 72% of children were walking independently and 87% could eat by mouth. 18% had epilepsy. Distinct patterns of associated malformations and syndromes were observed within each subtype. On average, children with aqueductal obstruction, cysts and encephaloceles had worse clinical outcomes than those with other forms of developmental hydrocephalus. 53% of surgically-treated patients experienced at least one shunt failure, but hydrocephalus associated with posterior fossa crowding required fewer shunt revisions.

**DISCUSSION/CONCLUSIONS:** We conclude that each subtype of developmental hydrocephalus is associated with distinct clinical characteristics, syndromology, and outcomes, suggesting differences in underlying mechanisms.
